MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet the following:

- Must be at least 18 years of age by August 3, 2026
- High school diploma or GED required

- Must be a U.S. citizen or authorized to work in the United States
 - Veterans claiming preference must submit a DD-214
 - Must obtain NCIC/RILETS certification after appointment
 - Ability to work in a fast-paced emergency communications environment
 - Strong verbal and written communication skills
 - Ability to multitask and remain calm under stressful conditions
 - Proficiency with computers, data entry, and office software
 - Working knowledge of or ability to learn public safety communications procedures and Newport geography

Written Examination

Expected the week of August 10, 2026.

Minimum passing score: 70%

Oral Board Interview

Conducted by Newport Police Department officials. Only top qualified candidates will be invited.

Background Investigation

Comprehensive background check conducted by the Newport Police Department.

Psychological Screening

Required for candidates selected to continue in the process.

ELIGIBILITY LIST

Successful candidates will be placed on the City of Newport's two-year eligibility register for future employment consideration.
